Introduction to Silver Stars

The Silver Stars Organization is committed to providing a quality, team-oriented dance experience through consistency, performance, and education. A Silver Star is expected to represent the Dance Department, Bowie High School, Austin ISD, and the greater Austin community through their daily actions, appearance, and their character. In carrying on a rich tradition, a Silver Star will exceed academically, volunteer within their community, and be an upstanding citizen of Bowie High School. A Silver Star will display kindness, self-discipline, honor, and respect at all times.

Purpose of the Silver Stars:

- To promote appropriate and good spirit
- To develop team-building, self-confidence, and self-discipline
- To promote leadership
- To develop and maintain exceptional dance qualities
- To represent the school, district, and community in an exemplary manner
- To serve as a role model for impeccable behavior and citizenship
- Silver Stars Varsity Drill Team Expectations

When a student becomes a member of the James Bowie High School Silver Stars, their entire family becomes a part of an extended family that include supporters, spectators, and volunteers. Being a Bowie Silver Star is one of the highest honors at James Bowie High School, as the Silver Stars are a representation of our student population, our school district, and our community. There is an incredible demand on the Silver Stars and their family that requires time, financial, and emotional responsibilities.

Time: Family schedules will sometimes have to be adjusted to accommodate the schedule and commitments of the Silver Stars Organization. This is a TEAM activity, meaning each member must be present for rehearsals and performances to run smoothly and effectively. Parents are asked to volunteer their time in order to facilitate performances, social events, and fundraising. Most importantly, it is imperative that families show their support of their dancer by attending the football games, booster meetings, and performances.

Money: Every effort is made to keep expenses reasonable, however, there is a considerable financial responsibility for each member. In an effort to offset some of the costs associated with being a Silver Star, the Silver Star Booster Club provides opportunities to fundraise, helping to defray costs. Each performer and their family must support these events by providing their time and talents, as well as encouraging the community to participate as well. Each team member directly benefits from these events.

Emotional Investment: Every dancer will have their triumphs and disappointments. With each moment is an opportunity for personal growth from an individual standpoint and a team standpoint. Celebrate your Silver Star's personal triumphs, as they have worked hard to achieve them. Be patient with them when they are disappointed, encourage them to ask for feedback, and recognize that with every moment of disappointment comes a wonderful opportunity for growth and reflection. Individual communication is paramount to the team's success.

Year-Round Commitment: The Silver Stars Organization is a year-round commitment. Once a student makes the team, it is expected that they will serve the entire year. Should they leave the team for any reason, their membership will be void until the next Silver Stars audition.

- Double blocked 1st and 5th periods. Practices are before school.
- **Football Season** - Silver Stars perform during halftime at all football games including away games and at all school pep rallies
- **Contest Season** - Silver Stars compete in the months of January-March
- **Spring Show** - Silver Stars host their annual Spring Show in April.
- **Summer Commitment** - Line Camp & Summer Dance Camp (June), Two-A-Days Practices (August)

If you do not have the equivalent of a 2.0 GPA at the time of auditions you will still be allowed to audition. However, if you are selected you will not be considered a member of the Silver Stars. You will be placed on academic probation and your membership will be contingent upon the fulfillment of a 2.0 GPA by the end of the academic school year. If you do not produce a 2.0 GPA by this time, you will not be considered a Silver Star for the following school year.

Non-Bowie (Transfer) High School Students

A student transferring from another school to Bowie High School for the 2026-2027 school year, will be allowed to audition during the designated audition timeframe. However, transfer students will be considered as alternates until the permanent transfer application is processed. You have to purchase the required items for Silver Stars and will not receive a refund if your transfer does not get accepted.

What do I wear during the clinic?

Wear appropriate form fitting dance attire (no shorts) with jazz shoes or half soles. Hair needs to be out of the face and tightly secured. Absolutely no gum or jewelry is allowed.

When will I learn the audition routines?

The audition routines will be taught at the audition clinic. All candidates will learn audition etiquette, a jazz/kick dance and a contemporary combination.

What will I wear for auditions?

Each candidate will be required to wear a **solid black** form fitting dance top or leotard (no stomach showing), and black leggings with tan jazz or half soles shoes. Long hair will be worn in a low bun with hair net, parted down the middle, bangs out of the face (bangs pulled back) and secured tightly with clips and/or hair spray/gel. If hair is unable to be put in a bun, it needs to be secured out of the candidate's face. Make-up and red lipstick is required. Every candidate will have an audition number displayed on the front of the audition top. Those numbers will be given to the candidates during the clinic, but you need to supply your own safety pins (at least 4).

How will I be judged?

Sample score sheets will be discussed during one of the clinic dates. All candidates will be scored on an equal basis. Candidates will audition in front of a panel of judges consisting of 3 judges. The candidates will be scored on splits, memory, kick technique, kick height, stamina, precision, advanced jazz technique, style, projection, quality of movement, and performance value. Auditions are closed to all spectators. The administrator, Directors, judges, person playing the music and candidates will be the only individuals allowed in the audition room. **All decisions made by the judges committee are final.**

What skills might be included in the audition dance?

Advanced jazz technique, advanced kick technique and advanced contemporary technique. The dances **MAY** include the following, **(please note the dances may not include all of these technical skills and may include other technical skills not listed):**

- Improvisation (3-4 8 counts)
- Executed with proper placement and technique
 - Right Triple Pirouette
 - Left Double Pirouette
 - Fouette Turns into Pirouettes
 - Turning Russian
 - Pique Turns
 - Russian
 - Leap/Stationary
 - Ballet Technique
 - Tilt Jump
 - Switch Arabesque
 - Calypso
 - Reverse Leap
 - Firebird

- Floor Leap
- Illusion
- Kip Up
- Right and Left Splits

When and where will the results be posted?

The results will be posted on SilverStars.org by 6:30pm Friday, February 27th. Team size will be determined by a natural break in the scores. The results of tryouts are **final** and cannot be appealed. Candidates that do not make Silver Stars have a one-week window from the time of results are posted to schedule a conference, at a mutually agreeable time with the Directors to discuss their individual scoresheets (March 2nd - 6th). After that date, you cannot view your scoresheets. As a reminder, the Directors are NOT judges and can only discuss what the judges wrote on their scoresheets.

If I make the team, then what?

The Directors will be in contact with you if you have been selected for the team with more detailed dates for Newbie members for the rest of the semester and summer. You may also check the Silver Stars website for dates.

Scheduling?

We will work with your counselors to change your schedule if you make the team for next year. We **highly encourage** the Rookie Silver Stars to take Dance 4 next year. This is a great opportunity to build on your technique and leadership skills with the Director.

Silver Stars Expenses

There are three separate types of expenses for Silver Stars.

1. Uniforms– Required items that must be paid in full before the beginning of the school year.
2. Fairshare– Fundraised or paid throughout the school year. Due dates directly correlate with fundraising opportunities.
3. Team Trip– OPTIONAL additional expense. Fundraised or paid for on a set trip payment schedule. (TBD) **26-27 is NOT a team travel year.**

Uniform Expenses

Below is a detailed breakdown of Uniform Expenses only. The following required items must be purchased once selected as a Bowie Silver Star. All prices are estimates based on expenses incurred in 2025-2026. **This list is tentative and is subject to change.** Items marked ** may be purchased at half price from members who are graduating.

If any family is financially incapable of fulfilling the requirements for attire and equipment, parents should visit with the Directors to investigate opportunities for sponsorships and/or grants.

Fairshare Expenses

Fairshare payments are made to the Bowie Silver Stars for the purpose of team operations such as: contest entry fees, travel expenses, choreography expenses, bus rental, hotel rental, prop making or

renting, costume buying/renting, Spring Show expenses, etc. Fairshare is due during the school year, as noted on the Silver Star Calendar via SilverStars.org. Fairshare is \$175.00 four times a year.

NOTE: The Directors create a budget for the Silver Stars each year based upon the number of participants, expenses incurred the year prior and the expenses for the current year. The Fairshare must be paid IN FULL by the annual Spring Show date, unless arrangements have been made with the Directors. Any and all questions in regard to Fairshare, or any other financial matter, should be directed to the Directors.

If your student decides not to continue in the Silver Star program after the first two weeks of school or is removed at ANY time during the school year, they are obligated to pay the full Fairshare amount for the entire year.

It is the intention of the organization for each Star to fundraise to pay for all fairshare expenses.

- The Silver Stars Organization sponsors three fundraising events
- The Silver Stars Booster Club sponsors several fundraising events
- The Fairshare amount will be set at the beginning of the school year

Optional Team Trip Expenses (26-27 is NOT a Trip Year)

- The Silver Stars take an optional trip every other year
- Trips could include a competition, masterclass, or performance opportunity
- Trips must be *paid in full* before the trip is taken
- All uniform and Fairshare payments must be up to date before fundraised money can be used toward the trip
